UPM Data Bank was established as a result of a memorandum of understanding between the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) and Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM). UPM has delegated the responsibility of managing the micro data services to the Library. Data supplied by DOSM include;

Household Income Survey:

- Year 2007, 2009, 2012, 2014
- 30% of the number of households with 22 variables

Household Expenditure Survey:

- Year 1998-1999, 2004/2005, 2009, 2014
- 30% of the number of households with the number of variables according to the survey

Labour Force Survey:

- Year 1982, 1985, 1988, 1997, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2012, 2015
- 30% of the total record of household members who are of working age 15 to 64 years

Population and Housing Census:

- Year 1980, 1991, 2000, 2010
- 2% of the total Malaysian population data

Yearly Manufacture:

- Year 2003, 2006, 2009, 2012
- Using Malaysia Standard Industrial Classification (MSIC)
- 30% of the number of individual organizations without weights
