INTRODUCTION

The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) is conducting the Survey of Household Income. Household Income refer to total incomes received (accrued) by members of households, both in cash or in kinds which occur repeatedly within the reference period (within a year, or more frequently).

OBJECTIVES:

- Measuring the economic well-being of the population, collecting information about the distribution pattern of household income according to various characteristics socioeconomics
- Identify the poor
- · Collect information about the basic facilities enjoyed by household
- · Assess the impact of the implementation of the development plan

HOW DATA IS COLLECTED

Personal interview method is used in which trained interviewers will visit households in selected living quarters during the survey period to collect information on all household members including their demographic particulars.
